Existing shed – Councillor R.Turner reported back to meeting on cost of replacing the existing shed with a number of alternatives. Matter debated with the conclusion being the existing shed to be demolished and removed. Councillor B.Jackson reported that he had the Sit on Mower and had cut the grass in the Play Area twice and was prepared to continue doing so. He also reported that he was currently storing the Mower on a trailer on his driveway. It was agreed this to be for the Summer/Autumn months only then the Mower to be relocated for Winter storage to Councillor Sowerby's Sheds. **Agreed**

Signage in Children's Play Area has not been updated, Chairman K.McCloud to investigate.

Councillor B.Smithson reported to the Council she had investigated the matter of the land and found it was purchased on behalf of the villagers in 1949 for £825.00. Councillor Smithson also advised she had copies of some of the Deeds and that Sue Warkup has the remaining deeds as far as she knows.
