Correspondence

The Clerk produced recent latest report in relation to ASBO's and local crime issues.

Cllr B.Smithson had obtained information in relation to the current problem with the locked gate between the Tennis Club and the Playing Fields and gave feedback to the Parish Council, the area of land was donated to the village and not to any individual organisation. Conclusion is that the Chairman should write to both Chairman of the Playing Fields & Tennis Club Committee's in relation to this matter. **AGREED**
