

BEEFORD PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of Parish Council Meeting 7:00pm, 4 July 2022, Beeford Community Centre.

Present: Councillors Mrs Adamson (Vice-chair), Adams, Mrs Dobson, Holmes, Robson and Turner.
Ward Councillor Mrs Evison, Police Community Support Officer Webster, two members of the public and Ms Rose (Clerk).

Absent: Councillors Sawyer (Chairman), Smithson and Sowersby.

1. Apologies for Absence

Councillors Sawyer (Chairman) and Wilburn apologised for their absences. Councillor Mrs Adamson (Vice-chair) chaired the meeting.

2. Approval of Minutes

The minutes for the meeting on the 6 June 2022 were approved.

3. Declaration of Interests

Councillor Holmes declared a non-pecuniary interest in items relating to the Beeford Afternoon Tea and Social Club.

4. Matters Arising

Unfortunately, Councillor Mrs Smithson is unable to continue as a Councillor and the Parish Council would like to thank her for her excellent service through the years and wishes her well in the future.

5. Correspondence

a. Public Space Protection Orders (PSPO)

The Parish Council accepted a proposal by East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC) to extend the existing PSPO's until 31 August 2025. Current orders are dog exclusions on the Children's Play Area and Primary School.

b. Councillor Training

The Parish Council approved the cost of training sessions offered by East Riding and North Lincolnshire Local Council's Association (ERNLLCA) for councillors who wish to attend.

c. Parish Council Cluster Meeting

ERYC are now offering a Town and Parish Council Event (below) which is a similar service and therefore the Cluster Meeting will not now go ahead. The Parish Council thanked the Ward Councillors for proposing the meeting.

d. Town and Parish Council Event

Councillors are invited to a meeting to discuss the services provided by ERYC Communities and Environment directorate.

e. Gypsy and Travellers Survey

The Parish Council completed the survey.

f. Beeford Afternoon Tea and Social Club

The Parish Council was thanked for its recent donation.

6. Planning

a. Applications

- i. 21/03986/PLF Land west of Manor House, Main Street. Erection of 40 dwellings with associated works and infrastructure following demolition of existing buildings (amended description and amended plans). **Resolution:** The Parish Council has no objections to the application but raised concerns regarding drainage and the pumping station.
- ii. 22/01881/PLF Land north of 94 Main Street. Erection of a dwelling following removal of existing garage. **Resolution:** The Parish Council has no objections to the application but raised concerns regarding drainage and the pumping station.

b. Proposed Main Street Road Closure

The Parish Council accepted an option for the road closure to take place in Main Street, North Frodingham during the half term school holiday 22 to 30 October 2022 between 9:00am and 3:30pm daily. The road will remain open to pedestrians to access. Contingency plans are in place to allow emergency services to pass through if required.

c. Town and Parish Council Planning Meeting

The Clerk updated the Parish Council with the main points of the recent meeting.

7. Lissett Windfarm

The Windfarm is in the process of considering applications received and first indications show that amounts applied for are in excess of the total fund available. There are no applications from Beeford to be considered at present.

8. Finance

a. Beeford Community Association Donation Application

The Parish Council deferred this matter until further information can be considered.

b. Financial Reports

The Budget Review and Finance Report were read and noted. The bank reconciliation was signed.

- The gardener for the playground will be asked to remove the dead tree, previously used as a message tree, and to fill the resulting hole. The Parish Council approved the expenses.
- Yorkshire Ambulance Trust have been contacted regarding the defibrillator and the next step is to check the electricity supply to the telephone box, quotes for the work will be sought.
- Part of the Yorkshire Wolds is being considered for designation as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, although the original submission by East Riding of Yorkshire was for a much larger area Further information is available and comments can be submitted on the website www.yorkshire-wolds-designation-project.org
- The footpaths near the bridges are in a poor condition and have been reported to ERYC.
- Three trees at the Church need attention and are being dealt with.
- The key for the noticeboards has broken, the previous Clerk will be contacted to see if any spares are available.
