

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BEEFORD PARISH COUNCIL

4. Matters Arising from the Minutes

A. Maureen Yates from Neighbourhood Network was invited to the meeting but did not attend or tender any apologies.

B. Dave Siddle EYRCC invited to September meeting – confirmed he will be attending

C. Cllr Brian Jackson attended Bus Service consultation 20th June 2016, and reported back to the Council that there would be no changes to the Beeford service at this time. Cllr Jackson also reported back that consultation meetings are still in progress, with further investigations into this matter during 2018 which may affect the Beeford service.

D. Cllr R Turner/Clerk attended the Town & Planning meeting held on 16th June 2016, Cllr R Turner gave feedback to Parish Council in relation to the changes to the administration of consultee planning applications on line. There is a possibility of some changes in regard to planning applications which will make the process of applying easier. Consideration of Neighbourhood planning along with flood structures. Cllr Turner's notes kept on file for future use. A further meeting is to be held in Beverley on the 20th July 2016 to which Cllr Sawyer will be attending.

E. Cllr Jackson removed the shed from the Play Area as agreed. Cllr Sawyer has got the Salt Spreader which works, strimmer and spares.

Correspondence

Cllrs Walden and R Turner attended the libraries consultation. Letter has been sent in relations to the proposed changes to strongly register disappointment and objection of any changes to the existing timetable on behalf of the Parish Council/residents which was duly signed by every member of the Parish Council. Letter/invitation received from Hart Bus Service read out.

General matters

The Chairman and Clerk attended an open day at the Bowls Club and whilst there the Clerk had a conversation with 2 of the Bowls Club committee who informed her that they were in the process of receiving quotations for the installation of a CCTV system. They also informed the Clerk that they had held discussions with the Playing Fields committee in relation to a remote link to be installed at the Changing rooms on the playing fields at which point the Clerk asked if there would be a possibility of a camera being installed which would cover the Children's Play area to which they advised they would ask the relevant question when they receive their quotations.

General Matters continued:-

Clerk to put Archive system in operation for historical documentation re: plans/correspondence etc. backdating to 2007, the Clerk advised the Council that this may incur extra hours, which was agreed in principal. **Proposed Cllr E.Walden Seconded Cllr R.Turner**

New Website was introduced by Clerk, with the eventual domain name to be Beefordpc.com. The site should hopefully ready to go live during September to the residents/general public. The Clerk passed round an Ipad with the initial format of the site for all Councillors present to see. The Clerk requested should any Councillors have any suggestions or pictures of the village they would be very welcome. The Clerk also informed the Council who would be able to see the website commencing August.

Cllr Wilburn mentioned the traffic disruption at the cross roads especially at the Skipsea road side near the Fish Shop, which causes traffic problems when people are parked on the junction, suggestions to resolve the problem were barriers/yellow lines/crossings, matter to be investigated further with ERYCC.

Planning

Application on behalf of Mrs Busby 57 Holme Farm – 3 dwellings – no objection – observations made in regarding to the potential flooding of the site along with the extra drainage that will be required along with the Hawthorne Hedge at front of the site. To be duly noted on the planning portal.

Children's play area

Ad placed in Beeford Buzz - responses from Beeford School, drawings/suggestions were handed in to the Council by Cllr E.Walden which was very much appreciated and will be taken into consideration for the future of the play area upgrade.

Need for more than one quotation to be requested.

Wicksteed to be contacted by the Clerk, inviting them to quote for upgrade/new equipment.

Proposed Cllr E.Walden Seconded Cllr A.Turner. **Agreed**

With regard to the upgrade, this will be ongoing for some time a lot of work needs to be done and a sub-committee has been formed consisting of Chairman K.McCloud and Councillors E.Walden, R.Turner.

Proposed Cllr R.Turner Seconded Cllr B.Jackson **Agreed.**

Quotation received to refurbish/repaint the existing play equipment in the Children's Play area, this was duly accepted by the Council with a potential start date in September after the School holidays.

Proposed Chairman K.McCloud Seconded Cllr I.Sawyer **All Agreed.**

It was also agreed to use a local resident of Beeford to keep the grass cut on a regular basis – quotation again accepted

Proposed Chairman K.McCloud Seconded Cllr R.Turner **All Agreed.**

Lissett Wind Farm

Annual meeting attended by Councillor A.Turner on the 16th June 2016 during which all grants received were debated, Councillor Turner informed the Council he had proposed that Beeford should receive a grant of £1250.00 and was successful in obtaining this on behalf of the Parish Council. The Chairman once again thanked Councillor A.Turner for all of his hard work and commitment in ensuring Beeford received their annual grant.
