### **4. Matters arising**

**a.** ERYCC Highways Improvement Works have begun on the A165, Beverley/Bridlington Road. Letter of notification was sent to all residents and business owners. An enquiry was made to the Clerk asking why the improvement works could not have been done in the evening, an email was sent to David Berry (ERYCC) to which a response has been received advising that the works had to be carried out during the day to minimise the noise generated by the equipment also it would place extra working time restrictions on any work thereby extending the work programme by approximately a further two weeks.

**b.** East Riding Local Plan Review Allocations notification has been received by ERYCC which was discussed in relation to Beeford village regarding the draft housing requirement (95) along with the capacity of committed sites (95) and capacity of existing allocated sites (12). This gives Beeford village a surplus of 12 for the purposes of the fact checking exercise. The local plan has now been extended for the period up to 2039.

**c.** The Clerk has arranged for the cleaning of St Leonard's War Memorial scheduled for October.
