a. AD Plant update - It was announced that Gascorp had withdrawn the appeal earlier in the day which was confirmed by the Planning Inspectorate. Dave Goodwin confirmed that it was decided that all monies raised would be held in the bank account until such time that assurances were in place that no further application for a smaller plant would be forthcoming. Dave Young addressed the Parish Council advising them of the amount raised to date by the events team along with advising that any future events for fund raising will still go ahead as planned. The Chairman together with all Parish Councillors were very delighted with the news and thanked everyone involved for their dedication and commitment to this campaign.
