4. Matters arising for discussion

a. Unfortunately due to personal commitments PCSO Alan Roberts could not attend the meeting, PCSO Sharpe attended the meeting in his place.

PCSO Sharpe qualified that in any accidents if there is no injury then there would be no police presence, this being due to lack of resources. There is a spate of number plate cloning which the police are aware of. There will be a new device for speeding very soon, once funding is in place, and this will be placed in areas of concern and will take full recordings of traffic flow.

Neighbourhood Alert is available to sign up and a text message/alerts will be sent regarding incidents in our area details will be displayed in Notice Boards and website updated. Sign up for free at www.mycommunityalert.co.uk. Probe, Home Security is still being offered to vulnerable residents. The issue of cars for sale parked outside the Tiger Pub was raised even though ERYCC have been notified no official response has been received. Cllr Evison stated Trading Standards are the people this needs to be reported to.

c. It was suggested that all of the Parish Council try to attend Remembrance Sunday if possible as it is the Centenary. Clerk to order a new wreath for Remembrance Sunday.

5. Correspondence received during recess for information/discussion

a. Letter was sent to Cllr Jonathan Owen on behalf of the Parish Council regarding further clarification in relation to New Homes Bonus Scheme. A response has been duly received from Cllr Owen to which the Chairman read to the Councillors, with the conclusion being that Cllr Owen offered his support with any future projects the Parish Council may suggest. Cllr Turner suggested that a traffic survey should be requested for next Summer when the flow of traffic is normally extremely busy. Cllr Evison concluded that unfortunately Grant cuts will continue but we must continue and ask for further support and gather as much information in support of this.
