4. Matters arising

a. AD Plant campaign - The target of £30,000 has been hit with events still to complete. A big thank you to the communities and fund raisers involved in the campaign.

b. BEPART will be an issue that involves the whole of the Parish Council and will continue to be discussed at future PC meetings. There is a First Responder's team in Beeford village and Mrs Hilary Winterbottom is the Co-ordinator. Also the Doctors Surgery is raising funds for defibrillators to be placed in both Beeford and Leven surgeries.

c. A letter was sent by the Clerk to Debbie McGurn regarding the bus stop situated at 106 Ivy Cottage. It has been confirmed that EYCC in conjunction with the bus company are looking at alternative solutions for the stop to be relocated.

d. A Cluster Group meeting was held on the 17th July - Ulrome - attended by Chairman McCloud and the Clerk as well as other members from Parish Councils in the area. This meeting was headed by County Councillors Evison and Owen together with Paul Bellotti, Interim Director of Environment & Neighbourhood Services, and Rob Cocker. Issues covered included speed restrictions/traffic management/footpaths. Chairman McCloud said that there are no repeater speed signs in the village. Cllr Evison confirmed that they are looking at having more of these meetings where different issues can be discussed and the possibility of starting a Parking overview Committee.

e. The Council's Monitoring Officer is scheduling a number of Code of Conduct training sessions for Town and Parish Councillors. A session at Cass Hall, Driffield has been scheduled for Monday 30th October at 7 pm. Any Councillor wishing to attend must notify Clerk as soon as possible.

f. Correspondence received from Mrs Sowersby regarding Beeford Lawn Tennis Club covering areas of fund raising and repairs to the Tennis Courts. A review of funding support for the club and Beeford Community Centre will be covered in the next PC October meeting .
