4. **Matter arising**

a. The Beeford Parish Council Code of Conduct (Pursuant to section 27 of the Localism Act 2011) was agreed and adopted by the Council.

b. Updated given by David Goodwin regarding the AD Plant Appeal. David confirmed that the date for the Public Inquiry was 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2017. The appeal for Holme on Spalding Moor is to be held in June. A new application for a similar AD Plant at Leven had also been made.

It was confirmed that Gascorp Delta had been formerly dissolved 17<sup>th</sup> January 2017. The NOW Action Group have requested clarification from the agent representing the Company and also the Inspectorate. The Inspectorate stated that the application was on the land itself and not the Company.

Chair Keith McCloud read out a copy of a letter which Vice Chair Robson brought to the meeting from the Rt Hon Sir Greg Knight MP in relation to to the Appeal stating that he has sent in his own letter of objection to the Planning Inspectorate asking that the appeal be rejected. There are still many questions to be answered regarding the complexities of the Planning Appeal and our support is fully behind the NOW Action Group in their continued efforts and dedication to this Appeal.

The Chair will order a banner on behalf of the Beeford Parish Council.

- a. Annual Play Inspection report was discussed. The Report was a satisfactory report but it was highlighted the need for the Play Area to be cleaned of moss growth and Algae that was present on the matting around the play equipment. Quotations had been received via the clerk and it was agreed that the Play Area be Power Washed.

- b. The new Aerospeed Cableway installation has commenced by Proludic. Cllr R Turner wished it to be shown in the minutes that a discount of £2,000 had been negotiated by the Clerk on the initial quotation and also a further reduction of £500 had been requested by the clerk from Proludic upon acceptance of their quotation. In total £2,500 has been deducted from the original quotation.

## **9. Lissett Wind Farm**

Cllr A Turner reported that due to the increase in the number of Wind Farms and the resultant increase in work load that a request had been received to stagger the opening dates for the Lissett fund in 2017. The dates are as follows:-
