#### **7. Planning**

a. 1 Rectory Lane - Conversion and alterations to existing double garage. No objections to this application.

#### **8. Children's Play Area**

a. Following Cllr Turner's report in relation to the LWFF grant being approved it was agreed that the Clerk should request finalised quotations/timings for the removal/installation of the new roundabout for the Play Area.

#### **9. Lissett Wind Farm**

a. Cllr Turner reported back on the LWFT panel meeting as Cllr A Turner was unable to attend. She informed the meeting that the Parish Council had been successful in their application for a grant for a replacement roundabout for the Children's Playground. The Community Centre was also successful in their application for a small grant towards a Sound System. This year the Bowls Club was not awarded a grant as the fund was over subscribed and they have benefited many times. Cllr Turner was concerned that policies had been introduced so that after declaring an interest each of the 7 local Parishes can no longer award points to their application and an average of the other scores would be used. Also the proximity to the wind farm would no longer be scored. This appears to be in contravention of the original concept of the Trust, which was to benefit residents in the parishes in close proximity to the wind farm location. Cllr R Turner suggested further clarification should be sort. The Chairman supported this proposal and all of the Councillors agreed.

#### **10. Crime**

a. Update received from PCSO Sharp that Traffic Officers have recently been in the village and 11 tickets for speeding (over a four hour period) have been issued and one for no seat belt.

b. PCSO Alan Roberts has sent an email stating that he will try and attend our meetings every other month as he also attends the Brandesburton Parish Council meeting which are at the same time. He is also looking at doing a police surgery at any upcoming group meetings/coffee mornings if required.

#### **11. Councillors updates**

a. Cllr Turner has reported an overgrown tree at Wharram Fields to ERYCC.

b. Cllr Sawyer to attend to the flower beds for the winter period.

c. Hazel Adamson mentioned parking at Beeford Community Centre which will be on the next Agenda for discussion.

The Chairman took the opportunity to thank both Vice Chairman Turner for his commitment to the LWFF and Cllr Sawyer for maintaining the flower beds within the village.
