- public notices relevant to Beeford village issued by East Riding of Yorkshire Council
- the agenda for the upcoming Parish Council meeting in line with legal requirements, and
- any such other notices either legally required or deemed necessary by the Clerk.

The undertaking of an annual review of the Parish Council website to ensure and maintain the relevancy and accuracy of its content.

The development and use of a Parish Council Facebook page as a digital noticeboard, not only to publicise Parish Council activity and notices, but also to forward on digital information currently published by Ward Councillors and East Riding of Yorkshire Council and any other information deemed relevant by the Clerk.
